Dynamic	How loudly or softly to play a part or piece of music
Pulse	The regular 'heartbeat' of a piece of music.
Rest	A moment of silence in music.
Rhythm	A pattern of sounds played through time, formed by a series of notes.
Tempo	The speed at which a piece of music is played.

Pulse The heartbeat of the music. Sometimes called the 'beat'.



We can clap along in time, we can move our bodies in time, we can march in time to the beat of the music.

Rhythm A pattern of long and short sounds.



Body percussion You can use your body as an instrument to play in time with the music too.
