- Taking part in sending and receiving activities

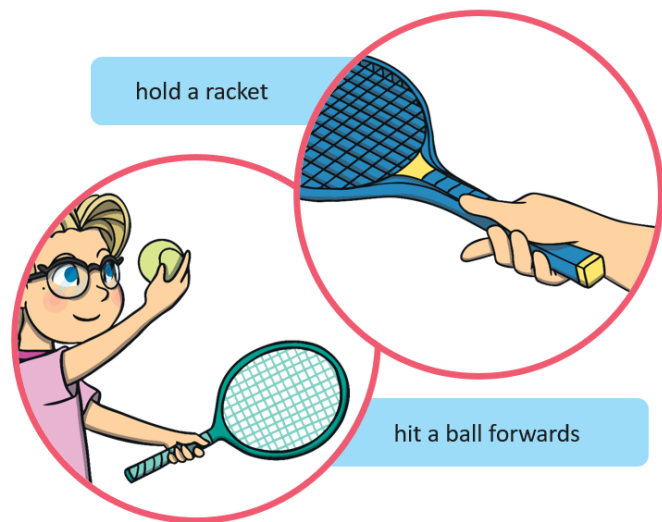
You will learn

- To know how to strike a ball with a racket/bat with some control and direction

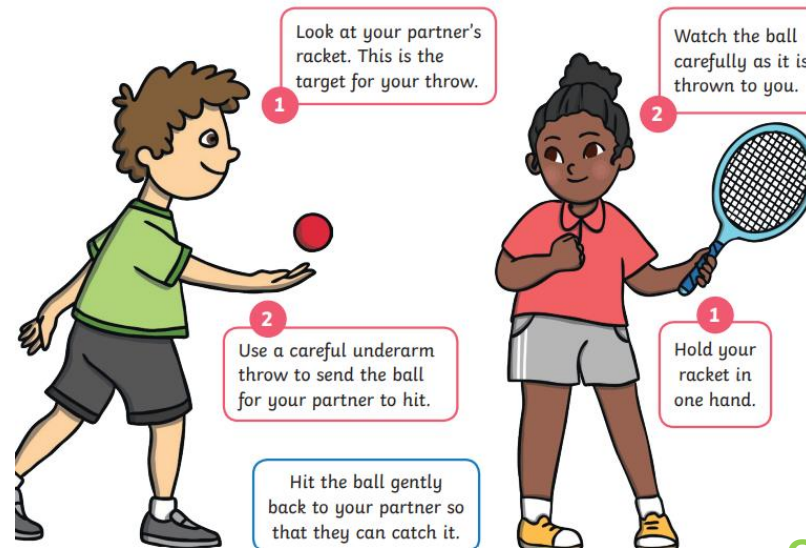
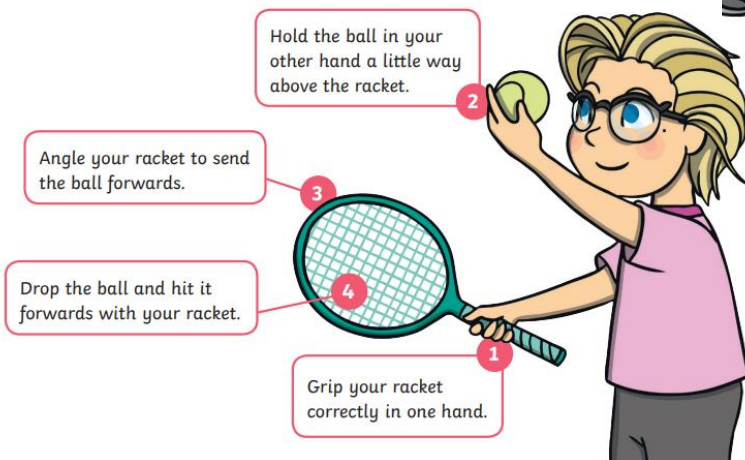
Vocabulary

Bounce	A ball moving up and down
Rally	An exchange of strokes between players
Racket	A type of bat used for tennis

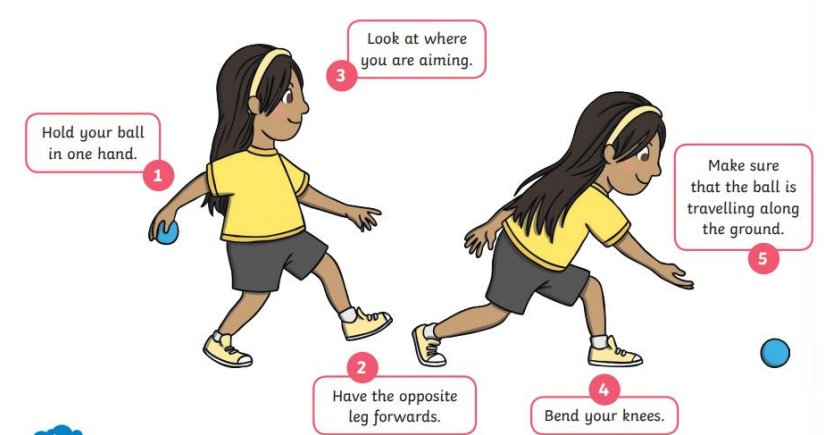
Holding a Racket



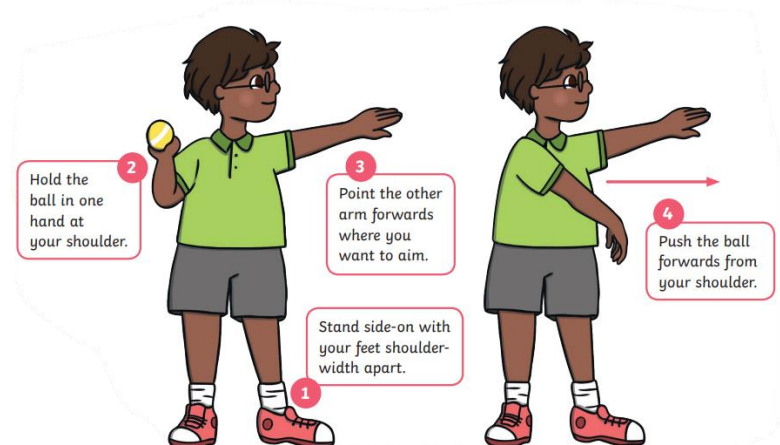
Hitting the ball forward
