The Golden Rule

Hurt not others with that which pains yourself.

This is the sum of duty: do naught to others that which if done to thee would cause pain.

Do unto others as you would have them do unto you.

No one of you is a believer until he desires for his brother what he desires for himself.

Rule - A set of regulations or principles	Charity - The voluntary giving of help.
Moral - Principles of right and wrong behaviour	Neighbourly - Acting in a way that make someone feel like they are part of your community.
Neighbour - Someone who lives close to you or in your community	Judgement - Opinion on right and wrong.
Sacrifice - To give something up	Local - Something or someone that is close by.
Samaritan - Someone who is very charitable and caring	Global - Something or someone that is all over the world.
