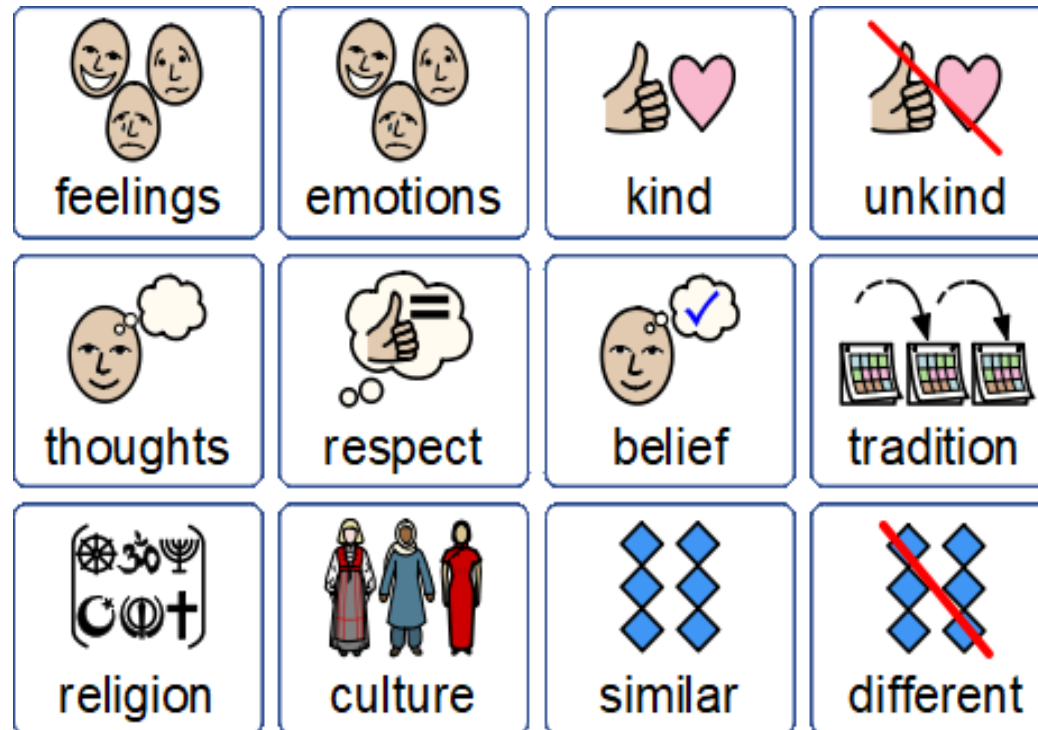


Theme: Where can we go on an adventure?

Area of learning – Personal, Social, Emotional Development (Cambridgeshire Personal Development Program Foundation Framework)

In Nursery and in Reception your child will learn the skills to:

1. Recognise and show their emotions.
2. Recognise emotions in other people and say how they are feeling?
3. Identify what causes different emotions in themselves and other people?
4. Find simple ways to make themselves feel better.
5. Find simple ways to make other people feel better.
6. Identify similarities and differences in the way people including families live their lives.
7. Value different types of people including what they believe in and how they live their lives.
8. Identify how do we celebrate what we believe in and how is this different for different people?



In Nursery and in Reception your child will learn:

1. We all experience different emotions during the day.
2. What causes different emotions in themselves and in other people?
3. How to make themselves feel better?
4. How to make other people feel better?
5. The way we and our families live can be similar or different to others.
6. Our beliefs can be similar or different to others.
7. Our routines, customs and traditions can be similar or different to others.
8. Our culture, race and religion can be similar or different to others.
