## What Is Worship?

Worship involves showing love or respect to something or someone. People who belong to a religion often worship a god or gods. Worship can happen in many ways. Some religious believers show their respect and love by looking at a picture of their god and giving special gifts to it. Other people pray or talk to their god while they worship.



## What Is a Place of Worship?

A place of worship is a special place within a religion where believers may go to:

- pray
- worship their god or gods
- learn about their religion
- spend time together as a community
