



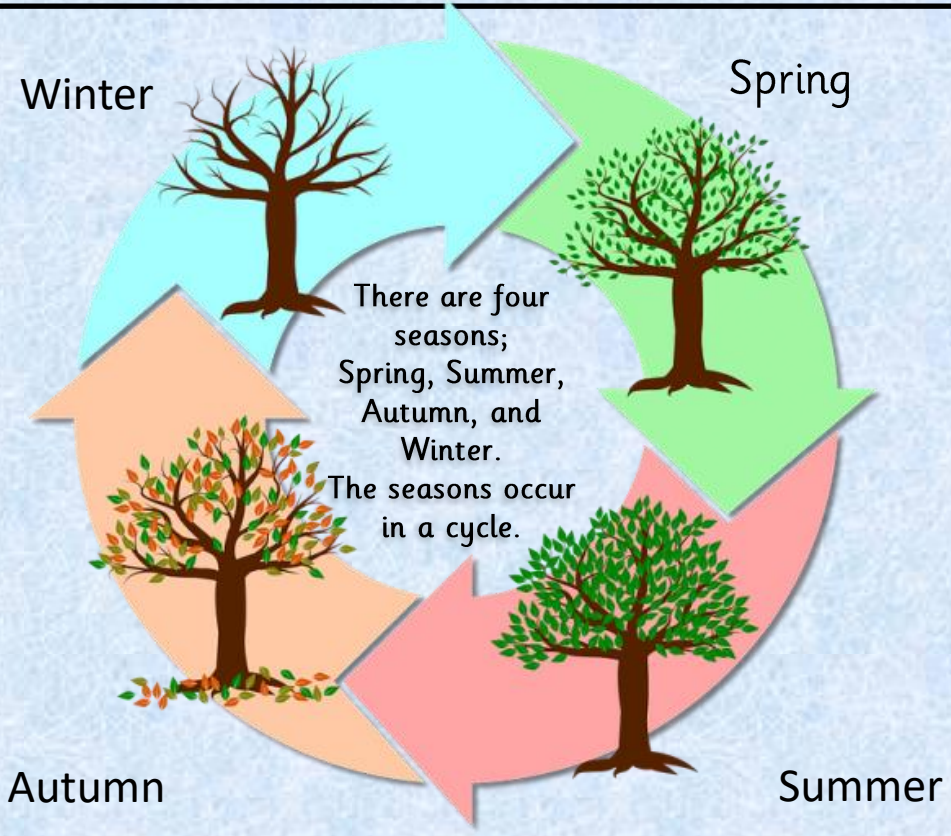
Knowledge Organiser - Seasonal Changes:

| Seasons | Times during the year – in UK we have four seasons – Spring, summer, autumn and winter |
| Weather | What it is like outside; sunny, hot, cold, cloudy, rainy, windy... |
| Sun rays | Light from the sun |
| Damaging | Causing harm |
| Daylight hours | Time between sunset and sunrise Sunset is when the sun goes down. Sunrise is when the sun goes up. |
