


Writing task:

We read this story in our Maths. How many toys should Kipper have in his toy box? Put 5 toys/objects in a box. Ask your child to cover their eyes while you take toys away. How many are in the box? Repeat with different amounts. Get them to use their fingers and numeral cards (from the rhyme bag) to show how many. Get them to count, using their finger to touch each item once, to check if they are correct.



Physical task:

We will be learning about: How do people travel into space?




