This week we have been practising counting sets of 5 using different ways to make sure we only count each object once.


Put 5 or 6 objects in a small bowl or cup e.g. pieces of pasta. Count them out of the bowl, back into the bowl, lining them up in a line only saying one number for each object.

Use the number rhyme in your bag to practise counting the objects.
