Weekly theme: St. George's day

Weekly question: What is a minibeast?

Phonics:

We have read the story:

[Snake Supper by Alan Durant, read by Kim](#)

We made a sad snake and a smiley snake.

Use the words beginning with 's' to make up a name for the snake's supper e.g. smelly snake supper. Use the snake puppet to show if it likes the supper e.g. show the smiley snake if it likes the supper.



This week's story is: Mad about minibeasts

We have been looking at the different minibeasts that might live in our gardens.

Writing:

Follow the lines to make the garden pictures.

Start from the left and join the dots.



Maths task: We have been learning to use **more** and **fewer** to compare 2 sets of objects.

See the ladybird pictures. Get your child to look and say which has more and fewer **before counting**, then let them count to check.

Use objects in the house to make 2 sets then compare using **more** and **fewer**.



Physical task:

We have been learning about how different minibeasts move – legs or no legs. Use the pictures below to name and then copy how they move e.g. I am a bee and I can fly.
