Maths task:

This week we have been learning to compare two sets of objects and say "more than", "fewer than". At home together with your child you can make up two sets of objects, e.g. 3 plates and 2 cups. Ask your child to count how many objects are in each group. Tell your child to say: 3 is more than 2. 2 is fewer than 3. Repeat the activity with different sets of objects.



Physical task:

Please create a physical pattern with your child. For example:

- Curl up small, stand up tall, curl up, stand up, curl up, stand up ...
- Star jump, wiggle, star jump, wiggle, star jump wiggle...
