Maths task:

We have been learning about wholes and parts. Watch this [Numberblocks - Series 1: The Whole of Me - BBC iPlayer](#). Talk to your child about the following: (they can show this on their fingers)

- 2 - 1 and 1 are a part, the whole is 2
- 3 - 2 and 1 are a part, the whole is 3
- 4 - 3 and 1 are a part or 2 and 2 are a part, the whole is 4
- 5 - 4 and 1 are a part or 2 and 3 are a part, the whole is 5



Physical task

Fine motor practice: Get a selection of socks, pegs and washing line or clothes dryer. Ask your child to peg the socks on the dryer or washing line. Tell your child they can only squeeze the peg with one hand. Let your child practice then give them a timed challenge: How many socks can you hang up in 1, 2 and 3 minutes?
