Dear Parents,

We have applied to the local authority to reduce our admission number from 90 places per year group to 60 places per year group. This is due to the falling number of pupils in the local area and, having consulted with the local authority, this picture is unlikely to change for the foreseeable future. This means that Coleman will become a two-form entry school rather than a three-form entry school. Making this decision will provide more certainty about pupils numbers moving forward and enable us to plan more effectively for the education of the children in our care.

This is the official notification that has gone out as there has to be a consultation process with the wider community, and this will tell you how to do that.

School Admission Arrangements 2027/28 Consultation

Leicester City Council is responsible for setting the admission arrangements for all its mainstream community and voluntary controlled schools. When changes are proposed to admission arrangements, Leicester City Council as admissions authority, must consult on their admission arrangements that will apply for admission applications the following school year.

We are proposing a change to the current admission arrangements from the start of the 2027/28 academic year. The proposal is to reduce the Published Admission Number (PAN) at Coleman Primary School from 90 to 60 places.
