Please read your reading book and share the books in your purple book bag. Read the words:

Writing task:

Practice writing the sounds we have learnt this week in phonics - oo and oo

Read the words on the sheet by looking at the graphemes, saying the sounds and blending the sounds together.



Maths Task: We have been learning about 3D shapes - cone, cube, cuboid, cylinder, sphere. Together with your child, can you find items around the house that are a cone, cube, sphere etc. Discuss with your child what properties the shape has - flat faces or curved surfaces or both.



Physical task:

Have an egg and spoon race outdoors, e.g. in your garden or in the park. Use a wooden spoon and pretend egg. You can use playdough to make an egg, a plastic egg or scrunch up a piece of paper into an egg shape. Can you run while balancing the egg on the spoon?
