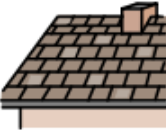


Theme – How does it work?

Area of Learning – Understanding the World
(Science, History, Geography and RE)

Knowledge:

1. That there are different types of houses in their close environment that people live in.
2. To name the outside features of a house - wall, window, door, roof, chimney.
3. To name the different materials houses can be built from - brick, stone, wood.
4. Bricks are stuck together with cement and laid in a pattern to make the wall strong.
5. What happens when they press a button, twist/turn a handle, etc.
6. To talk about customs and traditions of different beliefs. (Ramadan, Holi, Easter, Mother's Day)
