

Understanding of the World

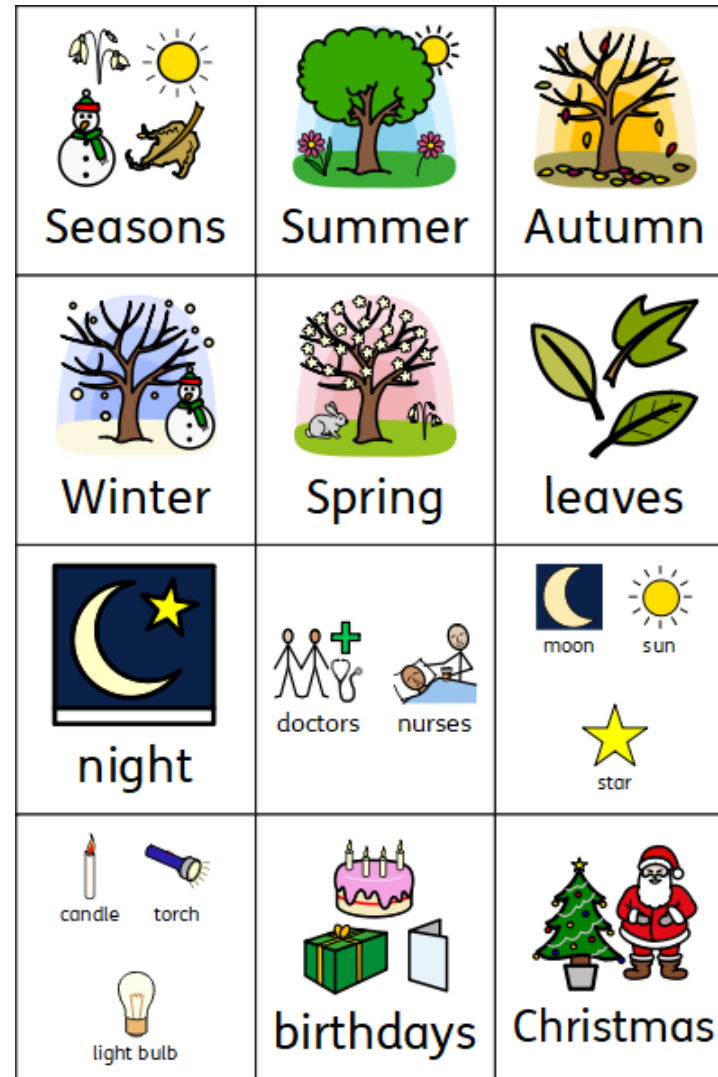

Theme – What happens at night?
Area of Learning – Understanding of the World (Science, History, Geography and R.E.)

Knowledge:

1. To know the four seasons are autumn, winter, spring, summer.
2. To know in Autumn some trees change because their leaves change colour and fall off.
3. To know the weather gets colder in autumn.
4. To know some people work at night e.g. taxi driver, doctor, nurse, fire fighter, police.
5. To know why people work at night e.g. a doctor because we need looking after in the night as well as the day.
6. To know that the sun is natural light.
7. To know that man made light can be a light bulb, candle, torch.
8. To know that electricity gives us light.
9. To understand that people celebrate birthdays in different ways.
10. To understand why Christian people celebrate Christmas.



Autumn, Winter, Spring and Summer are the four seasons.

The leaves in Autumn change colour, red, yellow, orange and brown, and fall off the trees.

Doctors and nurses work at night to look after us when we are ill.

The sun gives us light.

Candles, torches and lightbulbs give us light.
