Vocabulary

Parable	Stories that Jesus told to illustrate points he was trying to make in a way that his listeners would understand.
Samaritan	A person from Samaria , a country near where Jesus was teaching
Levite	A legal expert who would have known that it states he should help an injured man
Priest	A man who officially represents God.

Kindness

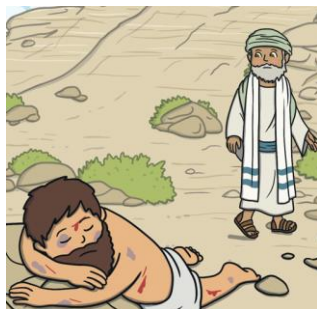
When have you been kind?
