- To know how to mix primary colours to make secondary colours

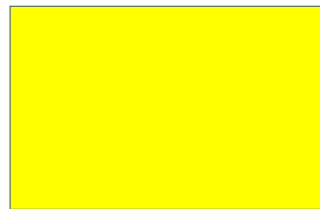
Vocabulary

Primary Colours	A colour that cannot be made by mixing colours
Secondary Colours	A colour that is made by mixing 2 primary colours
Tint	Adding white to a colour creates a tint
Shade	Adding black to a colour creates a shade

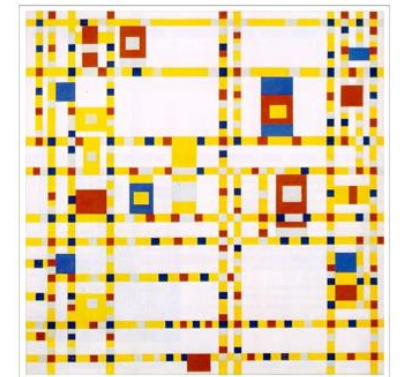
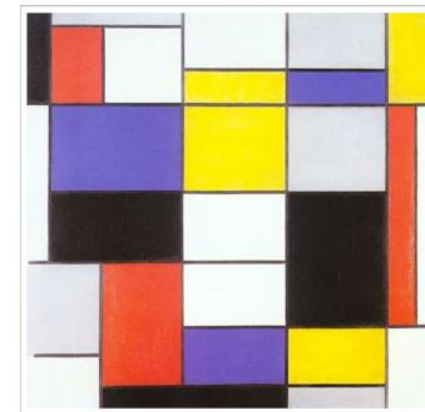
Yellow

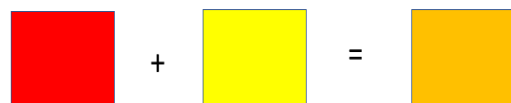
These colours can not be made by mixing any colours.

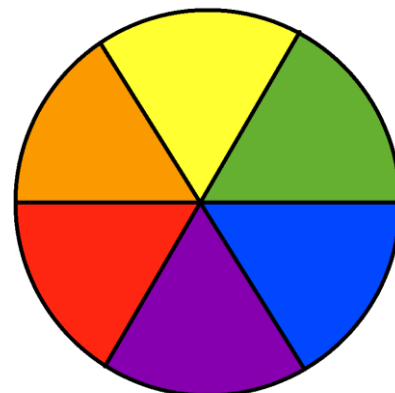

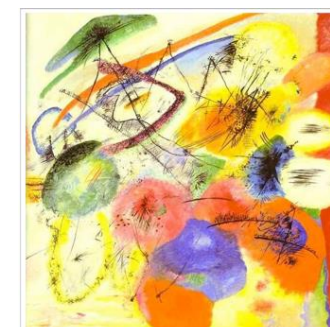
