Key Vocabulary: Beginning and Belonging

Belong: to be a member or part of a group or organisation	Support network: people who you trust and can talk to or go to for help
Relationship: the connection we have with other people	trust: the belief in the strength or truth of another person
Rules: a list of things we have to follow to guide our behaviour so we stay safe and happy	begin: to start something new
