Rights	Freedoms we have which are protected by laws
Responsibilities	Something that you are meant to do to protect everyone's rights
Democracy	A system where people vote fairly for representatives in a society
Community	A group of people living in the same place or having a particular characteristic in common.
Government	A group of people that have the right to rule according to the law
Parliament	A group of people responsible for making the law in a country and ensuring that people's rights are upheld
Rules	A set of instructions to keep people safe, maintain order in society and ensure fairness
United Nations	A global forum where countries can discuss difficult issues such as war and peace
Manners	Socially appropriate behaviours to ensure a safe and happy community
