We have been sprinkling rice to make our rangoli patterns.

Spread rice on to a tray. Use your finger to draw patterns or write letters in the rice.



Maths task:

We have been learning to recognise and count number 2.
Show 2 fingers, ask your child to find 2 shoes/ socks/ toys.



Physical task:

After you have drawn patterns in the rice use your fingers to pick up the rice to put it in a bowl.

Time to move – 2 jump/ hop/ clap/ stamp.
