Maths task:

Collect 5 items, e.g. 5 apples, 5 pencils and have one container ready too, e.g. a plate for the apples, a pencil pot for the pencils. Ask your child how many objects they can see. Tell them that this number is the whole. Then put some of the objects in the container, e.g. 2 pencils in the pot and 3 pencil not in the pot. Ask your child how many are in the container and how many are not in the container? Tell your child that **2 is a part** and **3 is a part. 5 is the whole.**



Physical task:

Can you practice the following skills:

1. Draw around objects on paper and cut out the shape. Use scissors suitable for children.
2. Squeeze cloths, sponges hard.
3. Hold a jar and twist off the lid.
