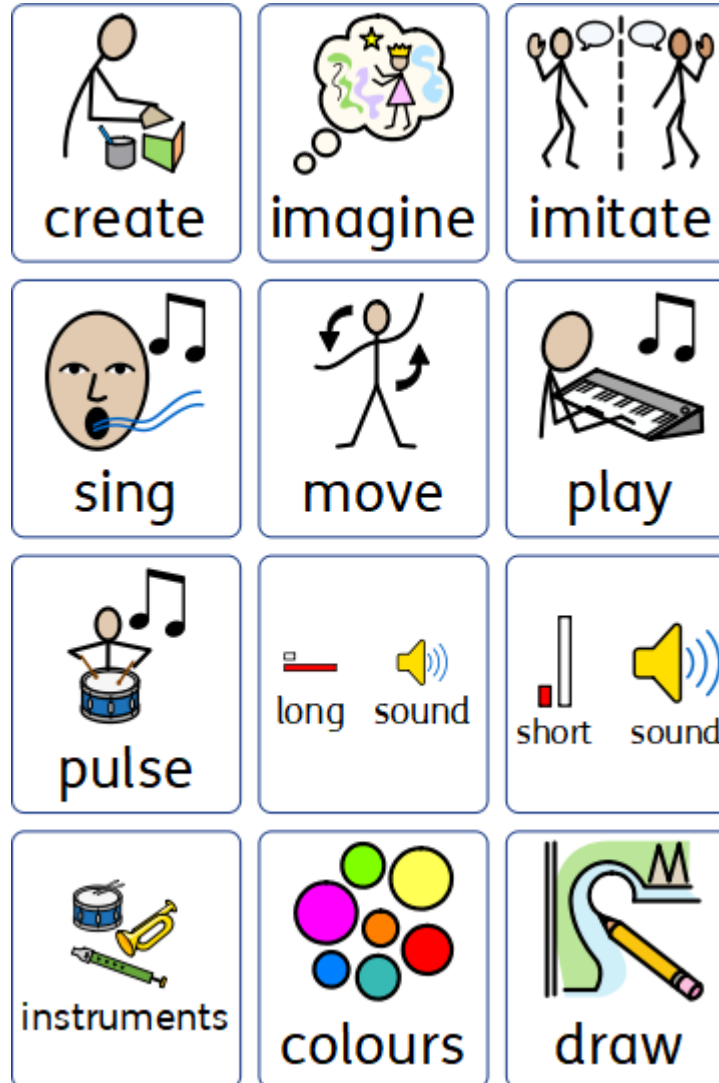

Theme – Where can we go on an adventure?
Area of Learning - Expressive Arts and Design
(Art, Design Technology, Music)

In Reception your child will learn the skills to:

1. Use complex story lines in their small world play.
2. Create different scenarios and environments using loose parts and construction equipment.
3. Use a range of musical instruments to create sounds as part of their imaginative play.
4. To imitate movements in response to music.
5. To keep a steady pulse with some accuracy (e.g. clapping, marching, tapping).
6. Create a piece of music using long and short sounds.
7. Draw accurate representations of objects.
8. Use appropriate colours when creating pictures.



In Reception your child will learn:

1. To create their own story lines while engaging in small world play.
2. To use loose parts and construction equipment in their imaginative play to create different scenarios and environments.
3. To create sounds using musical instruments to further develop their role play.
4. To respond to music with movements.
5. To tap out a pulse with some accuracy, using their body and musical instruments.
6. To create their own music using various sounds.
7. To draw people, animals and simple objects.
8. To accurately represent colours of animals, objects, etc.
