We have been learning about subitising to 3.

What is subitising?

At its simplest, subitising is being able to visually see a number of objects instantly without needing to count them out one at a time. Have you ever played a board game with your child and noticed that they are able to tell you how many dots are on the die without needing to count? That's subitising. (Taken from [Subitising | numeracy | early years - BBC Bitesize](#))

Can you collect 3 sets of different objects from around the house i.e. 3 buttons, socks, cars, bricks and put it in a bag. An adult to select different number of objects up to 3 from the bag and the children to tell how many objects they can see without counting, by holding up the correct number of fingers.

Sing the song 'If you're happy and you know it'.
