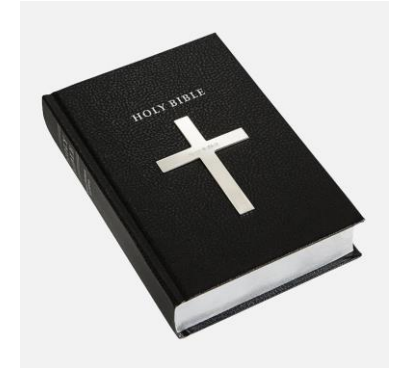

| <b>Christian</b>     | <i>A member of or following the religion of Christianity</i>   |
| <b>Jesus</b>         | <i>Whom Christians believe is the Son of God.</i>  |
| <b>Disciples</b>     | <i>A personal follower of Jesus during his life.</i>   |
| <b>Old Testament</b> | <i>The part of the Bible which explains God's relationship with his people before Jesus.</i>                   |
| <b>New Testament</b> | <i>The second part of the Bible which states how the world is saved through what Jesus did for his people.</i> |
| <b>Parables</b>      | <i>Stories told by Jesus that carried a special message or guidance on how people should live.</i>             |
