<b>Design</b>	A plan showing how something is to be made
<b>Bridge</b>	A structure built over a river, railroad, or road, that allows people to travel across.
<b>Materials</b>	Anything used for building or making something, e.g. wood, fabric, metal..
<b>Evaluate</b>	To study carefully and judge.
