237 BC



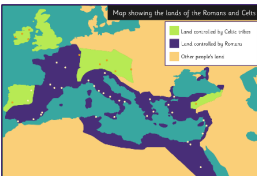
The Romans now control Italy and islands.

133 BC



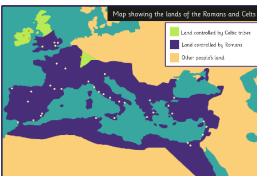
The Romans control Spain, Greece and part of North Africa.

44 BC



The Romans have invaded France and Germany.

79 AD



After three attempts, the Romans have successfully conquered England.

305 AD



The Romans control many countries but not Scotland.

Historical Skill Progression

Key Vocabulary: Romans

invade: to enter a country by force

settle: to decide to live in a place

BC: Before Christ. A date such as 3000BC means 3000 years before the year 1AD (there was no year zero)

AD: Anno Domini in Latin which stands for 'in the year of our lord'. A date such as 2018 AD means 2018 years after Jesus is supposed to have been born.

conquer: to take control of a place by fighting

Roman: a member of the Roman Empire

empire: a group of countries ruled by one leader

Celt: people who lived in Britain during and after the Iron Age

soldier: someone who fights in an army

army: a group of soldiers who are trained to fight in wars and invasions

artefacts: objects made by human beings

monument: something built to remember an important person or event

archaeologist: a person who learns about the past by digging up artefacts and studying them

emperor: the leader of an Empire



What you will know

- *To know that Rome was a kingdom followed by a republic and then an empire
- * To know how the Roman Empire spread.
- *To know that Boudicca was a Celtic leader who rebelled against the Romans.
- *To know that there are certain clues that tell us the Romans settled in Britain for a long time.
- * To know the features of a Roman Bath house that made it such an attraction
- * To know that Romans wore togas, tunics, sandals made from linen, leather and wool
- *To know that artefacts such as coins, bowls, dice told us how Romans spent their time.
