
### PSHCE—Diversity and Communities

#### Key Vocabulary: Diversity and Communities

<b>diversity:</b> many different types of things or people being included in something	<b>identity:</b> who you are, the way you think about yourself and the characteristics that define you
<b>community:</b> people who are thought of as a unit because they live together or they share common features	<b>media:</b> mass communication eg TV, newspapers, books, the internet...
<b>similarities:</b> having something in common or the same	<b>environment:</b> the surroundings where something lives
<b>differences:</b> ways that people or things are not the same	<b>responsibilities:</b> things which a person needs to do, often to help or care for themselves or others






