Key Vocabulary: Who inspires me?

inspire: to encourage others to follow a certain path

morals: rules that people follow; the difference between right and wrong

role-model: someone who people look up to or want to be like

Civil Rights Movement: a campaign for equal rights for Black Americans

leader: someone who encourages others to join and follow them

Suffragettes: a group of women who campaigned for equal voting rights

How do role-models inspire us?

There are many different people that might **inspire** others. When we feel inspiration, we feel enthusiasm from someone or something and it encourages us to behave a certain way or follow a certain path.

Role-models are people who **inspire** others. They might be famous or everyday people. They may be religious or non-religious. There are many different types of people who **inspire** others in different ways.


