Key Vocabulary

Pattern	An arrangement or design regularly found in comparable objects.
Texture	The feel, appearance, or consistency of a surface or a substance <i>Repeating:</i> recurring uniformly over a surface
Textiles	A type of cloth or woven fabric
Tiles	A thin square slab of glazed pottery or other material for covering floors, walls, or other surfaces
Geometric	Characterized by or decorated with regular lines and shapes
Symmetrical	Made up of exactly similar parts facing each other or around an axis
Tapestry	A piece of thick textile fabric with pictures or designs formed by weaving coloured weft threads or by embroidering on canvas, used as a wall hanging or soft furnishing.
