Key Knowledge Organiser:

Year 5- Autumn 2.

Invasion Games: Netball. In this unit, the children will develop a wider range of netball specific skills of send, receive, avoid dodge, attack, defend, movement into/ out of space and apply in to a small-sided and modified invasion game. They will develop the playing of games in groups; an understanding of game principles and space related to attack and defence. They will have opportunities to perform ball- handling skills with control and accuracy, as well as attacking and defending strategies within the competitive game situation, whilst constantly evaluating own ability in these situations.

Key Vocabulary

Control	A team tries to retain possession of the ball.
Dribbling	An attacking move where a player retains the ball.
Intercept	A player on the defending team stops a pass or takes the ball away from the opponent.
Moving into space	Running into a place on the pitch where there are no opposition players.
Pass	To keep possession of the ball by manoeuvring it on the ground between players.
Receive	The act of obtaining the ball from a pass or interception and getting it under control.
Shooting	Hitting the ball in an attempt to score a goal.
Tackling	To dispossess an opponent of the ball.
Tactics	A team's strategic plan using a particular playing style and system to win a game.
Team play	To work and play together as a team.

Key concepts to be explored:

Develop a wider range of netball specific skills including:

- Send and receive
- Avoid and dodge.
- Develop game play skills and principles in groups.
- Develop tactics of attacking and defending
- Moving in and out of space.

Core task:

In groups of 8 with one netball (3 v 3) on the court, two neutral players play for the side in possession of the ball. The game starts and restarts after a goal from a base line pass. A goal is scored by knocking down a skittle placed one metre beyond the attacking end line. Non-contact passing game and players cannot run with the ball.

Netball skills:

Invasion games (netball) skills learned prior to this unit:

- I can accurately pass to someone else and am aware of space and how to use it.
- I can choose simple tactics for sending and defending.
- I am beginning to influence the conditioned games with opponents.
- I can describe what others do well.

Invasion games (netball) skills learned in this unit:

- I am beginning to control, catch, send and receive a ball accurately whilst moving and keeping to the rules.
- I am starting to move with a ball in opposed situations and attack and defend in a small- sided game.
- I am beginning to take part in a conditioned game with some understanding of tactics and rules.
- I understand and can use principles of exercise activities for warming up and recognise how exercise is good for health.
