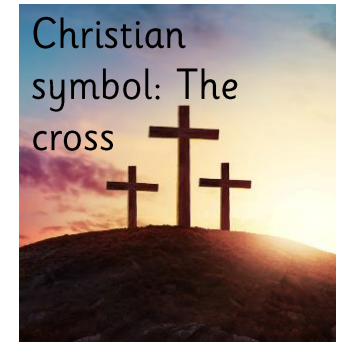
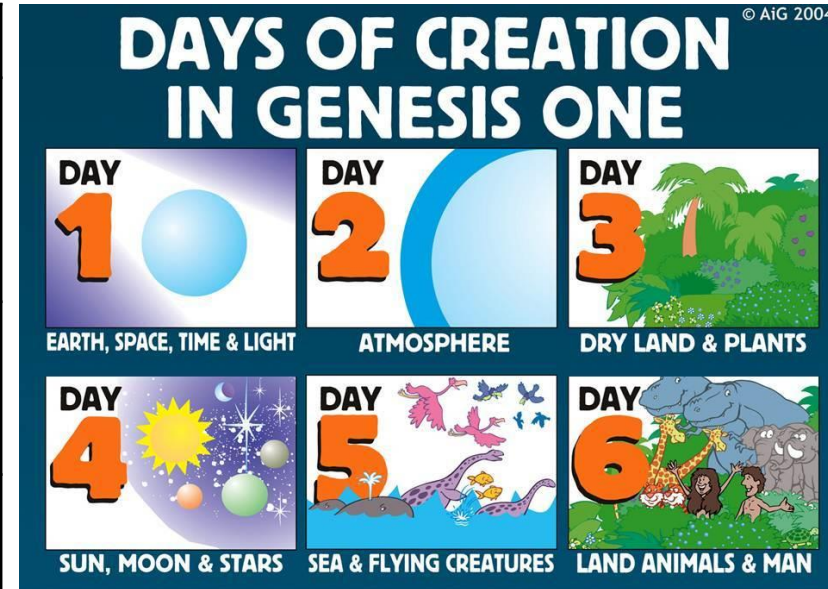




In this unit children focus on the Christian story of Creation and the responsibility a Christian might feel for caring for the world.

Key Vocabulary

Religion	A set of beliefs about how the universe was made and what its purpose is. Religion usually involves worship of a god or gods, and the belief in certain ideas about right and wrong behavior
God	A supreme being that is worshipped and believed to have special powers over nature or life and has created the universe.
Christian	A member of or following the religion of Christianity.
Creation	The act of creating or of causing something to exist.
Bible	Christian holy book
Environment	Everything that surrounds a particular type of living thing and affects its growth and health.
Responsible	To take care of specific jobs or duties.
World	The Earth and all the people and things upon it.
