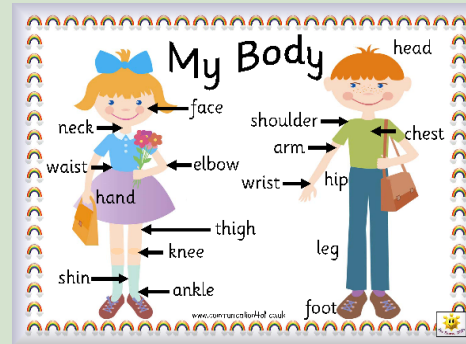




In this unit children will:
