Penguins

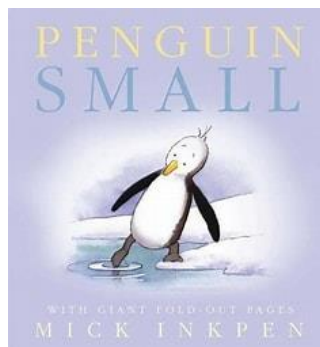
How do penguins move?
