Vocabulary	
Drugs	A medicine or other substance which has an effect when introduced to the body.
Medicines	A drug or other preparation for the treatment or prevention of disease.
Injection	A way of forcing a medicine into the body using a needle
Substances	Safe and unsafe liquids or powders
