To know what the Bible is and why it is important to Christians

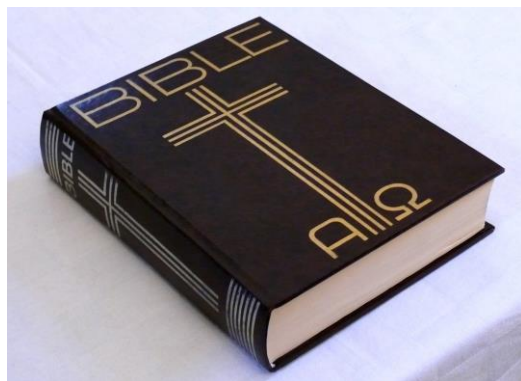
To know what the 10 commandments are and where they came from.

Vocabulary

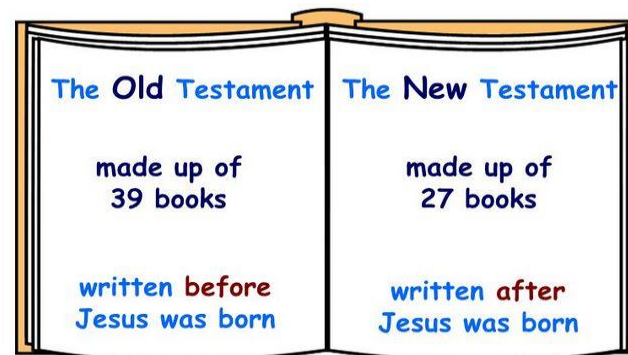
Christianity	The religion based on a person and teachings of Jesus
