**Vocabulary**

<b>Christian:</b> a follower of the Christian religion (a disciple)	<b>Disciples:</b> Followers of Jesus . First twelve were part of Jesus’ first ministry.
<b>Miracle,</b> event that goes against the laws of nature.	<b>Trinity:</b> Three connected, Father, son and holy spirit.
<b>Jesus:</b> Christian Son of god, Saviour, Christ, Messiah (Jew) Prophet (Islam) and healer (Other) to other faiths. A gift from god.	<b>Belief :</b> The act of putting faith into action
<b>Incarnation</b> God becoming man or literally being “made flesh”	<b>Pharisee:</b> Strict follower of the Jewish faith
<b>Healing:</b> To make something well again.	<b>Advent:</b> The four weeks leading up to Christmas Day.
<b>Power::</b> The divine force of god.	<b>Baths:</b> Areas for cleansing near the temple where there would also be beggars asking for money due to afflictions.
<b>Sin:</b> An act against the will of god
