Key Vocabulary: RSE

Penis: the male sex organ

Vagina: the female sex organ

Personal hygiene: the practice of keeping clean to stay healthy and prevent illness or disease

Bacteria/germs: organisms that cause illness and disease

Catch it -bin it -kill it: the process of using a tissue to blow your nose/ sneeze into, throwing it in the bin straight away and washing your hands soon after to prevent the spread of germs and viruses.

Personal hygiene

Catch it-Bin it-Kill it

Catch a sneeze or cough in a tissue (and use one when blowing one's nose). Throw the tissue in the bin straight away. Then wash your hands properly with soap and dry them to remove the germs and bacteria
