**Key Knowledge Organiser:**

**Year 5- Spring 1&2.**

**Invasion Games: Netball.** In this unit, the children will develop a wider range of netball specific skills of send, receive, avoid dodge, attack, defend, movement into/ out of space and apply in to a small-sided and modified invasion game. They will develop the playing of games in groups; an understanding of game principles and space related to attack and defence. They will have opportunities to perform ball- handling skills with control and accuracy, as well as attacking and defending strategies within the competitive game situation, whilst constantly evaluating own ability in these situations.

**Key Vocabulary**

<b>Control</b>	A team tries to retain possession of the ball.
<b>Dribbling</b>	An attacking move where a player retains the ball.
<b>Intercept</b>	A player on the defending team stops a pass or takes the ball away from the opponent.
<b>Moving into space</b>	Running into a place on the pitch where there are no opposition players.
<b>Pass</b>	To keep possession of the ball by manoeuvring it on the ground between players.
<b>Receive</b>	The act of obtaining the ball from a pass or interception and getting it under control.
<b>Shooting</b>	Hitting the ball in an attempt to score a goal.
<b>Tackling</b>	To dispossess an opponent of the ball.
<b>Tactics</b>	A team's strategic plan using a particular playing style and system to win a game.
<b>Team play</b>	To work and play together as a team.

**Key concepts to be explored:**

Develop a wider range of netball specific skills including:

- Send and receive
- Avoid and dodge.
- Develop game play skills and principles in groups.
- Develop tactics of attacking and defending
- Moving in and out of space.

**Core task:**

In groups of 8 with one netball (3 v 3) on the court, two neutral players play for the side in possession of the ball. The game starts and restarts after a goal from a base line pass. A goal is scored by knocking down a skittle placed one metre beyond the attacking end line. Non-contact passing game and players cannot run with the ball.

**Invasion games (netball) Knowledge learned prior to this unit:**

- I can accurately pass to someone else and am aware of space and how to use it.
- I can choose simple tactics for sending and defending.
- I am beginning to influence the conditioned games with opponents.
- I can describe what others do well.

**Invasion games (netball) knowledge learned in this unit:**

- I will control, catch, send and receive a ball accurately whilst moving and keeping to the rules.
- I will move with a ball in opposed situations and attack and defend in a small- sided game.
- I will begin to take part in a conditioned game with some understanding of tactics and rules.
- I will use principles of exercise activities for warming up and recognise how exercise is good for health.
